



# REC Captain's Meeting

## Notes 2020-21

1. New Day – Sunday has been added to Sneakers (who already had Tuesdays) This location may be used by any team for makeup games, please check with Jaime for availability. Some days already have a scheduled match that didn't quite fit into the schedule. Some Sundays will be used for tournaments to help players get sanctioned weeks. Please RSVP to the tournaments on the MPL fb page.
2. Sanctioning Tournaments at Sneakers on Sundays to allow any player to get their weeks in. MPL will be given preference. Ideally players would RSVP. Max allowed is 8 players. \$40 one-time sanctioning fee applies. More tournaments can be scheduled if the demand is there.
3. Teams will need to start games at 7pm till further notice. Please start play even if the whole team has not arrived by 7pm. Teams must be finished and out the door before 11pm. No exceptions. At last call you may order 2 drinks to last you. Teams must stay on track time wise. Teams should be at least at the halfway mark by 8:45pm. If not the REC teams must forfeit coaching for the rest of the match. Shot clocks may come into play. MPL is providing masks for all players, wearing one is still optional but encouraged by the bars.
4. Schedule hand out and questions. Contents of envelope. 2 schedules- 1 for the captain and one for the bag. Take a picture with your phone or save it to your phone from the website/FB. Posted tonight. Please read the schedule carefully. There are a few matches where a team does not play at their home bar. Keep in mind that we have 9 spots per week and technically 15 matches per week that need to be played.

### 5. COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS FOR PLAYERS

*League provides:* The League will be providing Lysol wipes and hand sanitizer. Each team will have face masks for those wanting to wear one or if it becomes necessary.

*What each team is responsible for:* Cleaning will be the HOME team's responsibility for Rounds 1 & 3. The AWAY team is responsible for Rounds 2 & 4. Players are asked to bring their own cues and chalk. Teams are also encouraged to bring their own set of balls (must be 2 1/4). Players have been asked to refrain from leaving their chalk on table. No hand shaking, hugs or fist bumps are allowed.

*Before each round begins:* The balls, top of table, rest, coin mechanism and rack are to be cleaned using the Lysol wipes provided.

*After each game:* Players are asked to wash/sanitize their hands before and after each game. The table top, cue, coin mechanism and rest if used will be wiped down again with the provided Lysol wipes. No spray cleaner is allowed.

*During the match:* We are asking players to visit from the respective seats also avoid visiting from table to table, or sitting with the other team. At the moment the maximum allowed per table is 6.

*Commitment to the rules:* MPL has made it clear to every player that the terms of playing are not negotiable and if found not following the rules set out by MPL, the host site and the province they are immediately removed from the league.

\*To play pool this is what we must do. Precautions are subject to change.

6. Playoff/Tier Eligibility - Teams can qualify 7 players at 5 weeks each with weeks to spare.
7. Gone Fishin has made the move to the REC league. Their goal is to have fun, relax and coach any player that's interested. Feel free to ask for their advice; these guys know a thing or two about pool.
8. Spares – no spares allowed this year. Tournaments available for sanctioning.

9. TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES FOR PLAYOFFS AND END OF SEASON - The following tie-breaking procedures will be used to decide which team is ahead of the other. Applies to two way ties: First Tie-breaker is head-to-head records. Second Tie-breaker is highest winning percentage excluding forfeits. If teams are still tied a playoff will be required. The tie-breaking system for 3 teams or more will be followed until all positions are determined. If three or more teams are tied: First Tie-breaker is points accumulated between tied teams. Second Tie-breaker is wins accumulated between tied teams. Third tie-breaker is highest winning percentage excluding forfeit wins.
10. Team Registration Fees are within 4 weeks of start time. Last year's Cabin teams will have their registration paid for in full (\$80). All other new Cabin teams will get \$25 towards their registration fee. Teams do not have to ask for this but please give your thanks.
11. How to pay for fees
  1. NO CASH will be accepted or drop boxes used – co-vid precaution.
  2. 4 match pre pay available for the team. \$112 up front.
  3. E-transfer Email: [Info@missionpoolleague.ca](mailto:Info@missionpoolleague.ca) Password : MPL2014 Your e-transfer will be declined if the password is not MPL2014 or the note section is blank. If declined late fees will apply. (Take of discussion Captains Meeting) Please add Week # and your team name to the note section. This is for record keeping. The scoresheet must be text messaged or FB messenger to LO. LO = Jaime Derewenko 604-751-6663
12. Late Fees- Stats and fees must be handed in by **Friday 6pm**. Late stats will be charged a fee of \$7 per week they are late. Incomplete stats (including players wins) there will be a charge of \$7 for each team for a total of \$14. This is to ensure captains check the scoresheet and sign it at the end of the night not at the beginning.
13. ADDING /DROPPING PLAYERS - players may be added or dropped at any time during the regular season. Please be aware of the eligibility requirements for playoffs when adding new players.
14. Team Captain/Co-Captains Expectations – Remind players when they play, to watch their games and most importantly teach your teammates the rules and etiquette/sportsmanship of the game. Reviewing the scoresheet before signing. Captains please bring the equipment bag every week. Must brush the table before play. Ensuring co-vid precautions are always observed.
15. QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE. Average Shot is 20 Seconds. Special Shooting Situation is 45 Seconds. Time-outs/coach is 1 Minute. You may ask anyone who is a MPL member to act as coach, they are allowed to refuse. A coach is not a teaching moment. After the match is when teaching happens. As a guide coaching periods should not exceed one minute.
16. Banquet – last years banquet will not be taking place. Instead we will have a online doorprize tables. Take a look at the items up for grabs, msg me your pick and a week later we will do a live draw for the winner. This will take place October/November.
17. Website and Facebook – sign up for feed burner and join the Facebook group, where you are welcome to post pool related pics, iSO/for sale items, questions
18. Equipment handout must Sign out. Please be aware you will be expected to pay the replacement cost. Replacement cost is - Cue Ball \$25 + Claw \$40 + Bridge \$10 + Brush \$15 + Bag \$15 = Total \$105. All equipment needs to be numbered for easy identification when returning or if lost. It must be handed in before the banquet. Always check your equipment number.
